## Itinerary

### SATURDAY 11 MAY

The coach will leave from the church at a civilized 9.00 am and head north past Stirling and Perth for a stop at Glendoick Garden Centre, where we were served delicious rolls and bacon or rolls and sausage and did some shopping in the excellent shops there on our trip to Aberdeen. There is room in the coach for purchases of plants as well.

After a stop of an hour or so, a half hour journey will take us to Dundee, where the afternoon is ours. If you wish to visit the V&A on arrival or have some lunch (if you have saved yourself for lunch rather than the bacon rolls) you are quite free. The coach is available for those who would like to visit Broughty Ferry, which is just outside Dundee and has some lovely shops too.

We will have copies of the booklet 99 Things to Do in Dundee with a map and a list of the interesting things available for all tastes.

Tickets for the V&A are FREE and Audio Guides are available.

A tour of Scott and Shackleton's RRS Discovery is available too at £8.75 for a concession ticket.

## ACCOMMODATION

This year our Hotel is the Doubletree by Hilton Hotel in Dundee which has all the amenities you would expect from a Hilton Hotel. It is a former Scottish mansion house in vast grounds which has modern extensions. The rooms are equipped with TV, WiFi and every comfort, while the hotel has sauna and swimming pool available. Indeed some people might be happy to spend the afternoon there and that can be arranged.

After dinner we will have a room to ourselves where we can chat or sing and dance to our heart's content.

### SUNDAY 12 MAY

We will worship with a local congregation in the morning and, dependent on the weather, head towards St Andrews for a few hours before heading back over the beautiful Queensferry Crossing and back to Killie for 7.00 pm

We are very fortunate to have the coach at our disposal for the trip and the services of our

## COST

The cost of the weekend, including coach, overnight accommodation, with dinner and breakfast, is £105 with no single supplement. A deposit of £30 per person should be paid and handed in along with the Booking Form overleaf as soon as possible, to secure your place.
